He has been nominated in the “Best Doctors in America” directories 54 times for the past two decades. He is Blokhin Gold medal (Russia) and Ellis Island Medal of Honor holder (USA). Recently to honor his tremendous contribution and international leadership in head and neck surgery, MSKCC has established “Jatin Shah Chair in Head and Neck Surgery and Oncology”. The International Federation of Head and Neck Oncologic Societies has established “The Jatin Shah Lecture” at its world congresses, and the American Head and Neck Society has established the “Jatin Shah Symposium” at its annual meeting.

At international level, he has been a great mentor to many leading head and neck surgeons. He established IFHNOS as a global network of head and neck societies with a mission to popularize Head Neck oncology worldwide. An extension to his thought process of grooming knowledgeable and well-trained head and neck surgeons, he has developed and led the “IFHNOS World Tour Program”, a global CME program in Head and Neck Surgery and Oncology, offered in 26 countries over the last six years. He has established an online fellowship program in Head and Neck Surgery and oncology in collaboration with IFHNOS and MSKCC. He is one of the most sought mentor in head and neck fraternity can be proven by the fact that he is a visiting Professor to 48 countries around the world.
